- Describe a positive aspect of your immigration.
- Tell your group members something you appreciate about your native country.
- Tell your group members what you appreciate about this country.
- Talk about a person/organisation that was very helpful for your integration.
- Describe a challenging experience you made during your immigration.
- If you could pick a country around the world where would you rather live and why?
- Tell/Show your group members gestures that are welcome and gestures that are taboo in your native country.
- Tell/Show your group members how people greet each other in your native country.
- Tell your group members three things about your native land. Two of them are true and one of them is a lie. Ask people to guess which one is the lie.
- Which other languages are spoken besides the dominant language in your native country?
- What foods and drinks are popular in your native country?
- Tell your group members three things that are taboo in your native country, but considered normal in this country.
- How do people greet each other (handshake, kiss, embrace)? How do they say goodbye to one another?
