Title of Resource:	Multinational School of Faneromeni/ Breath of Air Films
Why use this resource?	<p>This film describes the common life of multinational students, attending Faneromeni school in Nicosia. All the students guided to co-exist by their teachers and to show respect to each other’s culture.</p> <p>The school complex of Faneromeni in the heart of the old city of Nicosia has been indicated as an Educational Priority Zone by the Ministry of Education because of the high density of students with a different linguistic background and the low socioeconomic and educational level of the students’ families.</p>
What will you get from using this resource?	The film provides methods of integration of children and the effort of teachers and students to understand each other’s culture. The young people who wish to become leaders in their communities will be able to witness real incidents of intercultural encounters through this experimental film.
