| | Description | Example |
|---------------|--|-------------------------|
| "search term" | Exact search for the search term. This will refine your search and exclude synonyms. | "Graz Austria" |
| + | Force an exact-match search on a single word or phrase. | Vienna + bakery |
| * | Match any words and phrases. | ocean * beach |
| 0 | Group multiple terms or search operators to control how the search is executed. | (sea OR ocean) waves |
| - | Exclude a term or phrase. | Harry -Potter |
| \$ | Search for prices. It works also for Euro (€) | Pineapple € |
| IN | Convert one unit to another. Works with currencies, weights, temperatures, etc. | 50€ in GBP |
| OR | Search for X <i>or</i> Y. This will return results related to X or Y, or both. | Pizza OR Pasta |
| define: | Google will define the word like a dictionary. | define:accomodation |
| site: | Limit results to those from a specific website. | site:exemplars.eu |
| intitle: | Find pages with a certain word (or words) in the title. | Intitle:erasmusplus |
| info: | Find information about a certain page. | info:erasmusplus.com |
| source: | Find news results from a specific source. | source:erasmusplus |
| related: | Find sites related to a specific domain. | related:erasmusplus.com |
