Topic:	Parallel societies
Title of Resource:	Are there parallel societies in Germany?
Why use this resource?	The term "parallel society" stands for an alleged failure of the integration of migrants and for the end of the idea of a multicultural society. The article explains the concept and deals with the fear of parallel societies in Germany.
What will you get from using this resource?	The article offers a differentiated discussion and quotes numerous scientific studies about parallel societies. It helps the reader to develop his or her own view and to focus also the tasks of the majority society in avoiding parallel societies.

Why use this resource?	The film "Willkommen auf Deutsch" deals with the social impact of asylum and refugee policy. The focus of the documentation is the often cited "welcoming culture" and the question of open-mindedness to migrants in Germany.
What will you get from using this resource?	The film gives a differentiated picture of what fears and problems, but also what possibilities of rapprochement and compromise can arise through the influx of asylum seekers in a neighbourhood. "Willkommen auf Deutsch" is controversial and moving, the film shows that the situation is difficult but not hopeless.
